

INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR RESIDENTIAL ADDITION

1. A survey or site plan showing the proposed location of structure as well as other structures on the lot with setback and side yard dimensions shown along with distances to other buildings and structures on the property (pools, decks, well, etc.). Setback requirements depend on zoning districts (See Town of Addison Zoning Ordinance).
2. 2 complete sets of plans of the structure including foundation plan, floor plan with room sizes, window sizes, door sizes, dimensions, wall section(s), and elevations. Truss drawings need to be provided before inspection. Provide with permit application if possible.
3. Washington county land use sign off sheet/ shoreland zoning permit obtained from Washington county planning and parks department. Located at:

4. Completed Town of Addison building permit application

Minimum Zoning requirements-(Other requirements may apply)

- Addition must meet setback, and height requirements.
- If adding bedrooms, the powts (septic) may be tested (Washington County)

Construction requirements

- Shall be constructed per methods outlined in State of Wisconsin Uniform Dwelling Code (DSPA 321-325)
- Electrical and plumbing require separate permits.
